


Mean and Quartile Estimated Gross Earnings (in 2017 Dollars) for Alaska's Limited Commercial Fisheries, 1975-2017

Abstract

This publication examines annual gross earnings (in 2017 dollars) for permit holders in all limited commercial fisheries in Alaska for the years 1975-2017. Summary statistics provided include mean gross earnings, and the lower (first) quartile, median, and upper (third) quartile for the gross earnings. A list of limited fisheries in Alaska with regulation information, relevant dates, and ratios of adjudicated permits is also included.

The figure on the cover depicts gross earnings (in 2017 dollars) for Bristol Bay drift gillnet fishery from 1975 to 2017.

Introduction

In 1972, Alaskan voters amended the state constitution to allow limited entry in the state's commercial fisheries. Following the amendment, in 1973 the Alaska State Legislature enacted the Limited Entry Act (AS 16.43), giving the Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission (CFEC) the authority to administer the program. Permit fisheries are defined by CFEC as a specific gear type for a fishery resource within a defined administrative area.

This report provides a list of Alaska's limited fisheries, and counts of fished permits with gross earnings for all limited permit fisheries from the CFEC gross earnings file.

The CFEC gross earnings file is based on ADF&G fish tickets and is augmented with CFEC permit holder and other data. The ex-vessel value for salmon in the CFEC gross earnings file largely come from the Commercial Operators Annual Report and ADF&G fish tickets with some additional information provided by processors. All ex-vessel values are adjusted for inflation using the from the 2017 Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index.

Gross earnings are reported in real (2017) dollars. Summary statistics include mean (average), 25th quartile, median (50th percentile), and 75th quartile gross earnings. To produce the quartile earnings, all earnings by permit were first ordered from smallest to largest gross earnings. The median is the middle value or the mean of the two middle values if there is an even number of permits fished that year. The 25th quartile is the middle value of the median and the lowest value, and the 75th quartile is the middle value between the median and the largest value.

Some figures are masked for confidentiality. 25th and 75th quartile earnings are hidden when fewer than 16 permits were used to make landings. When fewer than four permits were fished, both the median and mean earnings are marked as confidential.

Table 1. Limitation of Alaska Commercial Fishing Permits. This table has information for each limited commercial fishery in the order as presented in the body of the report. Included in the table are: permit code; description of the permit type; the regulations that defined the limitations along with important dates; when interim-entry and permanent permits have been issued; and the percent of permits that have been issued. Only permits that were or could be issued as permanent permits are included in these figures.

Table 2. Mean and Quartile Estimated Gross Earnings (in 2017 Dollars) of Permit Holders in Alaska's Limited Commercial Fisheries, 1975-2017. This table summarizes annual earnings for each limited fishery. All ex-vessel values are adjusted for inflation using the 2017 Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index. Included are the mean and quartile earnings to provide references to both the expected value and skewness of what a commercial fisherman could earn. When fewer than four permit holders are presented, earnings are masked due to confidentiality.

Discussion

This report focuses on landings by permits, not individuals. While permits can only be held by one person at a time, they can be transferred either permanently or temporarily to multiple individuals in any given year. For information on changes of permit holdings through time, please refer to the latest annual Transfer Study publication¹.

In certain years for some fisheries, permits have been used either in stacked or dual permit operations. For these fisheries, the actual number of permits fished will not be accurately represented and the average earnings could also be affected. A stacked permit operation is where a single permit holder holds two permits with the benefit of an added measure of gear; dual permit operations occur when two permit holders work together and are allowed to increase the amount of gear for the operation. Permit stacking has occurred in several salmon set gillnet fisheries: Kodiak (S04K) from 2008 to 2010; Bristol Bay (S04T) from 2010 to 2012; Cook Inlet (S04H) since 2011; and in limited circumstances in Yakutat (S04D) since 2012. Dual permit operations occur in two salmon drift gillnet fisheries: Bristol Bay (S03T) since 2004 and Cook Inlet (S03H) since 2008. The Southeast herring gillnet (G34A) fishery has had dual permit regulations in effect since 2006.

As estimated earnings have been adjusted for inflation, differences in annual averages values across multiple years can be considered. Because of the open access competitive nature of State of Alaska managed fisheries, variation exists in average earnings by permit for each of the fisheries. Average earnings by year also show variation due to environmental and social influences, such as the Exxon Valdez oil spill and farmed salmon.

In March of 1989, the Exxon Valdez struck Bligh Reef in Prince William Sound and spilled more than 10 million gallons of crude oil. Several fisheries were affected by the spill from Prince William Sound to Kodiak as can be observed by both a decrease in participation as well as a reduction in average earnings in the years immediately following the oil spill.

By the mid-1990s, production of farmed salmon began to exceed wild salmon harvest. The increased production of farmed salmonids had an impact on the market for wild Alaska salmon and it reached a low point in the 2000s. Many commercial fishermen have since adapted. For example, in Bristol Bay almost all commercially harvested salmon is now chilled before it is delivered to processors.
