**Notes :** \* 2004 data are preliminary and incomplete.  
Gross earnings are estimated using an average annual ex-vessel price per area, species and gear type. Yearly totals represent data that has been aggregated across all salmon fisheries.  
For this report, Total Permits Issued is defined as follows: all permanent permits, regardless of whether they have been renewed, and interim entry permits that have been issued (renewed) for the given year. Excluded from Total Permits Issued are any permanent permits that have been revoked and any interim entry permits that have not been issued (renewed) for the given year. Interim entry permits are interim use permits issued in a fishery which is under limitation. They are issued to qualified applicants who are awaiting the final determination of their application.  
The drop in number of total permits issued from 1995 to 2004 is primarily due to forfeiture of non-transferrable hand troll (S 05B) permits.
