In 1984, nonresident commercial fishermen filed a class action against the State of Alaska challenging the constitutionality of the higher annual fees charged to non-Alaskans for commercial fishing licenses and permits. The lawsuit, *Carlson v. State*, includes as plaintiffs all persons who paid any non-resident commercial fishing license and permit fees to the State of Alaska from December 13, 1984 through licensing year 2004. If you held a nonresident crewmember license or nonresident permit during this time, you may be owed a refund with interest. Please see the commission's web site here for a list of class members and the preliminary calculation of overpayments and underpayments for each individual.
