

Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission Notice of Intent to Permanently Transfer Entry Permit

This notice must be on file with the Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission (CFEC) for at least 60 days before the permit may be permanently transferred to another person. Filing a *Notice of Intent to Transfer* does not obligate you to permanently transfer the permit and you need not name a proposed transferee in this notice. Please complete all sections of this form to avoid delays in processing. Please submit via mail,fax, or email to **dfg.cfec.licensing@alaska.gov**.

This notice expires one year from the date of filing. If a new *Notice of Intent to Transfer* is received prior to the expiration date, it will be effective immediately without an additional waiting period. Name, address and licenses held are public information that may be released. A *Notice of Intent to Transfer* is not required if a permit is being transferred from the Estate of a permit holder who is deceased.
