

NOTICE OF A PUBLIC MEETING

COMMERCIAL FISHERIES ENTRY COMMISSION

Notice is given that the given that the Alaska Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission will hold a public meeting to take action on its regulation proposed October 22, 2004 to establish an optimum number of entry permits for the Bristol Bay salmon drift gillnet fishery. The commission proposed an optimum number from 800 to 1200 permits. However, depending on public comment and further analysis an optimum number finally adopted could have different boundaries. The public comment period for this regulation closed on June 22, 2005.

The Commission will conduct the public meeting on **October 5, 2005** at 3:30 p.m. in the Commission's Conference Room 8800 Glacier Highway, Suite 109, Juneau, Alaska. The public is invited to attend the meeting. However, the purpose of the meeting is to allow the Commission to reach a final decision, and, therefore, no public testimony will be accepted at the meeting.
